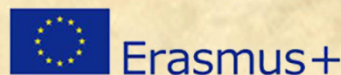

Practical information travel

Change rate: 1 Euro – 27, 30 (please pay attention where you change your money – some of this services have commission or bad rates – ask us before you change ☺)

Arriving with bus/train to Mělník: please contact us and we will wait for you at the train station/ bus station and we will bring you to the place (there is no public transport in Mělník, but we will pick you up by car).

Airports: We propose to fly to Prague, Brno, Wien, Berlin, Bratislava. In case you are flying to Brno, Wien or Bratislava you have to take a bus or train to Prague, all this cities are aprox. 3 hours and here you can find a very good connection via Bus www.studentagencybus.com/en or train www.tmel.me/bahn or <http://tmel.me/PSmum>

We will pick you up from Prague the meeting point will be in Prague main train station (Praha Hlavni Nadrazi), Prague Airport or in the bus station Prague Florenc (Autobusové Nádraží Praha Florenc). For this you will have to let us know until 20September your travel details.

Just for your information from Prague to Mělník there is a connection each hour until midnight. In general you have to go to the Bus Station Holesovice (Zastavka Holesovice) and from there to take the bus to Mělník. Also from Prague Main Train Station (Praha Hlavni Nadrazi) you can take the train to Mělník. Here you can see all the possible connections: www.tmel.me/jizdnirady.

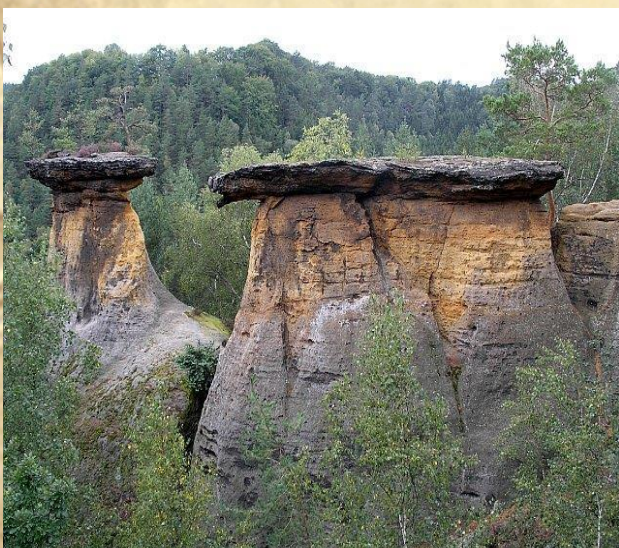


About Mělník

The town of Mělník lies on the elevation of the River Elbe lowlands some 30 km north of Prague .

This ancient royal dowry town became famous as a centre of the agricultural region for its cultivation of grapevines and for holding a celebratory grape harvest every year. The impressive dominant features of the town, ones that are visible from afar, are the chateau and the tower of the Church of St. Peter and St. Paul (chrám sv. Petra a Pavla). Visitors are attracted to Mělník by the view offered from the chateau observation tower, where you can see the confluence of the Elbe and Vltava rivers, the memorable Říp Mountain and the Bohemian Uplands (České středohoří). In addition to its historic monuments, the town offers a wide range of cultural and sporting entertainment.

One particularly popular part of the Mělník area is the romantic Kokořínsko, an area of beautiful countryside, sandstone rocks and a 14th-century gothic castle.



Financial condition

There will be no participation fee; food, accommodation and activities costs are covered by the project budget. If you plan to travel outside the official project dates you need Tmelník's approval first you can contact us at info@tmelnik.cz. Also you should wait for your approval before you are booking the tickets. The tickets for travel outside the official travel dates purchased or booked without Tmelník's approval may not be reimbursed. The maximum reimbursable budget for the travel cost (return ticket) per person taking in consideration the distance from the home of the participants until Mělník is:

Summary of the training course

“You(th) are Creating an Inclusive World!” is a training course for youth workers, youth leaders and social workers that are working with youth/youngsters with fewer opportunities. The training course will be held in Czech Republic, Mělník and will get 25 youth workers from Turkey, Slovakia, Hungary, Czech Republic, Poland, Romania, Spain, Italy and Portugal.

The main aim of the project is to present LARP (Live Acting Role Play) and role-play as a non-formal tool to promote tolerance and inclusion.

During the training activities the participants will have the opportunity to share their experience and earn more knowledge and also to earn practical skills on creating sessions using non-formal tools on the topic of inclusion. So the participants will get to know more about inclusion, tolerance and disadvantages group. Also the participants will have the opportunity to experience and create role-play and LARP games on inclusion.

The **objectives of the project** are following:

- developing the competence of the 25 participants to use LARP as a working method;
- promoting tolerance and inclusion by using different non-formal methods;
- gain more knowledge about inclusion and groups with fewer opportunities;
- creating a blog page/ PDF guide how to use LARP to promote inclusion;
- to develop the skills of the participants to create LARP scenario on inclusion;
- developing the partnership between partners non-profit organization;
- developing the cooperation and participation of 25 youth workers and youth leaders from different European countries on inclusion;

Working methodology: non-formal.
