Training course on competence building for youth workers

KA 1- Mobility of youth workers – training course

Summary of the project

- « The "Level up!" project is a KA1 mobility of youth workers under the Erasmus+ program, revolving around a Training course which focuses on enchanced competencies of youthworkers, in general. The project aims to cultivate and enhance competencies of youthworkers and their work linked to the Erasmus+ programme. The project has the following objectives:
- to improve competences of participants in regards to youthwork in international settings
- to enhance participants' competences in using non formal education in youthwork
- to cultivate competences of participants in using Erasmus+ programme as a tool for learning and social change
- to provide the adequate setting for sharing experience and ideas of common interest

During the 7 days of activities 20 youth workers, youth leaders, public body representatives and project managers from various countries will be part of a common setting for building strong competencies in order to obtain high quality in the implementation of future projects under Erasmus+.

Based on non formal education tools and methods, participants will undergo a complete process of identifying quality aspects, improve and synchronize with partners.

DATE & VENUE

The TC will last 7 days, 2-8 September 2018, and will take place in Sabbioneta/Viadana area in northern Italy.

It is our intention to host participants in a nearby 3-4 star hotel, with all amenities, where we'll also have most of the activities. Meals will be served at the restaurants available at that time, but also we are looking forward to a barbecue evening/swimming pool, traditional home made food at some local villas etc.

Considering it is a training course, participants have to able to speak English at least at B2 level. These conditions are vital for the project as we all want proper results.

PARTNER'S AND PARTICIPANTS ROLE

- **PREPARATION**: identification of the participants per partner and support to them in the research activities and preparation of the mobility (documentation of youthwork in respective organization, online interviews, flight, pre-departure information, etc)
- **IMPLEMENTATION**: participants have to actively participate in all the proposed activities of the programme; *prior to the arrival ,partners will receive the info pack.*
- **FOLLOW UP**: all the partners and participants have to contribute to the development of visibility activities of the project and dissemination of the project results (using their own web solutions, organizing if possible a further training sessions locally/regionally with co-nationals, using and reporting the use of the results in a future youth project).
